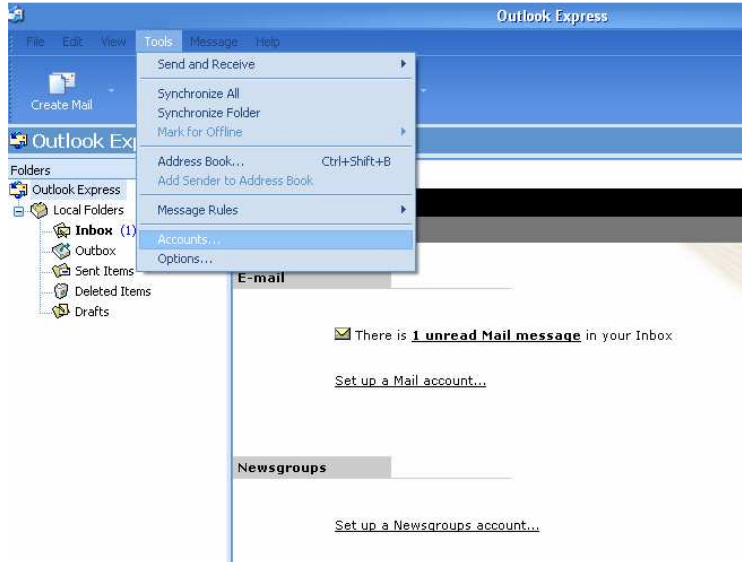


Yless4U Outlook Express Email Configuration

Open Outlook Express

Click on **Tools**, and then click on **Accounts**



Click on **Add**, then Click on **Mail**



Enter in your name as you would like recipients of your mail to see it
– e.g. John Doe

Click **Next**>

Enter in your Yless4U email address
– e.g. john.doe@yless4u.com.au

Click **Next**>

Choose **POP3** from the pull down menu

Type in **mail.yless4u.com.au** for both the incoming and outgoing mail servers

Click **Next**>
